Notice of Race

1. Place & Date

**Bala Sailing Club,
Saturday 30th June and Sunday 1st July 2012**

The Organising Authority is Bala Sailing Club.

2. Rules

Racing will be governed by the ISAF RRS, the relevant Class Rules and the Bala Sailing Club, Sailing Instructions 2012.

2.1 Racing Charter

Competitors should note that Bala Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 – 2012).

2.2 Liability Limit

The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the owner/person in charge or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/person in charge, warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races. This condition does not override any statutory rights.

3. Condition of Entry

Saturday and Sunday Long Distance Handicap Races

The event is open to all boats with an established PY number.

The RYA Portsmouth Yardstick Scheme as set out in the current YR2 will be used.

4. Programme

Saturday Registration from 10am Briefing at 11.00am

Start of race at **12noon** Length of Race either 2 or 3 hours. The whole length of the lake may be used.

Prize Giving In the clubhouse within 1hour of the last boat finishing.

Sunday Registration from 9.30am Briefing at 10.15am

Start of Race 11.00
